RESOLUTION NO. 2026-15

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR
THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS,
AUTHORIZING RECORDER-TREASURER
TO ACCEPT DONATIONS
THROUGH THE "CAMP SPOT" SYSTEM
FOR CITY'S USE TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS
TO THE FAIRFIELD BAY PARK (CAMPGROUND);
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, The City Council for the City of Fairfield Bay, the Mayor, and other City personnel have identified some pressing needs at the Fairfield Bay Park, including the potential need for overhauling the courtesy boat dock before the expiration of the City's current lease, as a matter of public safety; and

WHEREAS, The City's needs are not part of its annual budget, but will be needed for making certain repairs or replacements before the 2027 season begins on or about April 1, 2027, so the need to begin seeking donations is immediate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS:


1. That the City Council authorizes the Mayor and the Recorder-Treasurer to add a "donation" option to the Campspot electronic reservation system currently in use, and to segregate funds donated through this electronic channel into a sub-account of the City's segregated Campground account. The funds are for lawful purposes of the City, restricted to the purposes of making repairs, renovations, safety improvements, and other modifications to the Fairfield Bay Park (Campground) currently leased from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
2. The Recorder-Treasurer shall maintain a separate accounting in her records for donations made for this purpose in this calendar year 2026, and in calendar year 2027. Donated funds shall be designated as "unavailable for appropriation" by the City for any purpose other than these uses, as specified herein for persons making donations through the Campspot system.
3. The Mayor and the Recorder-Treasurer be, and they are hereby, AUTHORIZED TO TAKE any and all appropriate actions necessary in accordance with this Resolution. The City is authorized to make such public notices and disclosures as

the Recorder-Treasurer deems reasonable under the circumstances for persons making donations through the Campspot system.


4. This authorization is effective immediately following its approval by the City Council. The Mayor and the Recorder-Treasurer likewise shall follow recommendations of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and Arkansas Legislative Audit, if any, respectively. Repairs, upgrades, renovations, and other modifications to be made in 2027, will be made a part of the City's "Plan of Operation" for the next season at the Fairfield Bay Park.
5. The City Council takes this opportunity, in conjunction with the Mayor, the Recorder-Treasurer, and the citizens, residents, taxpayers, voters of, and visitors to, the City of Fairfield Bay to **THANK the City's donors for their generosity and contributions to the City of Fairfield Bay Park (Campground).**
