RESOLUTION NO. 2026-34

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR
THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS,
AUTHORIZING CITY TO SEEK GRANT FROM
WHITE RIVER REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT,
FOR ROLL-OFF CONTAINER FOR THE
FAIRFIELD BAY'S HIPPE RECYCLE AND EDUCATION CENTER;
FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING
DECEMBER 31, 2026;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, The City of Fairfield Bay (City) has multiple needs for support at the Fairfield Bay Hippe Recycle and Education Center; and

WHEREAS, The City has identified a potential source of funds from the White River Regional Solid Waste Management District which requires matching funds from the City, as discussed at a recent City Council work session; and

WHEREAS, The City's Recycle and Education Center is entirely staffed by volunteers who have provided extraordinary service to the City for decades;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS:

1. The City Council finds and determines that the City may qualify for a grant from the White River Regional Solid Waste Management District, for purchasing a Roll-Off container for the City's Hippe Recycle and Education Center.

2. The City has not budgeted for this purchase, but is always seeking to leverage funding opportunities to help preserve its fiscal integrity, including seeking funds outside of the City on a donation or grant basis.

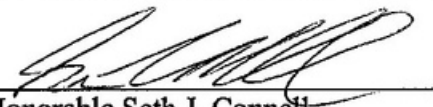
3. The City Council therefore approves a potential grant application for the White River Regional Solid Waste Management District, with the understanding that this would be a grant requiring the City to match funds on a 75/25 basis (75% by grant, 25% with City funds), requiring the City to allocate funds from another source, for purchase of a Roll-Off container. For the purposes of this application, the City's projected maximum expenditure will be no greater than \$2,000.00, assuming the Roll-Off container will not exceed a total purchase price (including delivery) of \$8,000.00.

4. The Mayor, and the Recorder-Treasurer, be, and they are hereby, AUTHORIZED TO TAKE any and all appropriate actions necessary to put this Resolution into effect, for the calendar year ending December 31, 2026. A separate Resolution to amend the Budget may be required if any grant is received.

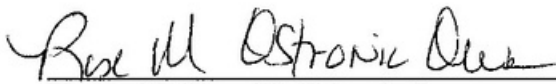
5. The City Council also takes this opportunity to express its gratitude to the volunteers who selflessly staff the Hippe Recycle and Education Center, and have done so for decades.
