A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY  
CONCERNING MOVING THE  
GENERATOR FROM  
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY  
FOR THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY  
TO CITY-OWNED BUILDING AT  
137 GARDEN LANE,  
CURRENTLY HOUSING SURVIVAL FLIGHT CREW QUARTERS;  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR 2023, ACCORDINGLY;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

**WHEREAS**, The City of Fairfield Bay has recently received estimates, pursuant to informal requests, to move the current Generator (with manual operation) from the Department of Public Safety, across the street, to the City-owned building at 137 Garden Lane, where Survival Flight currently leases space for its helicopter crew quarters; and


**WHEREAS**, the City has received and reviewed the estimates, which are both less than the Mayor's current authorization, and less than the minimum amount requiring formal bidding, and has approved an estimate provided by Lockwood Electric, for \$14,000.00 for the purpose of moving the current Generator across the street to 137 Garden Lane, and installing it (with its manual operation) at the City-owned building at 137 Garden Lane, Fairfield Bay, after review by the City Council;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRFIELD BAY, ARKANSAS:**


1. The City Council has reviewed the Estimate to move the Generator from the Department of Public Safety to the City-owned building at 137 Garden Lane, Fairfield Bay, from Lockwood Electric, in the amount of \$14,000.00.
2. The City Council hereby APPROVES the estimate for moving the Generator from DPS to 137 Garden Lane, Fairfield Bay, in the amount of \$14,000.00, after discussion, at the City Council Work Session.
3. The City Council hereby APPROPRIATES FUNDS, from general funds in the City's General Revenue account, for the purpose of paying for moving the Generator from DPS to 137 Garden Lane, to pay Lockwood Electric, in the total amount of \$14,000.00.

4. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to retain the services of Lockwood Electric for the purposes of moving the Generator from DPS to 137 Garden Lane, accordingly.
5. The Mayor, and the Recorder-Treasurer, are hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to put this Resolution into full force and effect, immediately from and after its passage.
6. An amendment to the 2023 Budget Ordinance may be made, separately, in accordance with the City's usual practice of amending the Budget by Ordinance after the close of the calendar year.
7. This authorization and appropriation is valid from January 1, 2023, through and including December 31, 2023.
